## \$7000 RAISED FOR HUNGER RELIEF BY CAPITAL REGION FOOD PROGRAM'S 3<sup>rd</sup> ANNUAL GOLF TOURNAMENT

CONCORD, NH — Seventy-four local golfers and over fifteen local businesses helped raise in excess of \$7000 during the 3<sup>rd</sup> Annual Capital Region Food Program (CRFP) Golf Tournament, held Thursday, September 23 at Concord's Beaver Meadow Golf Course.

"Players and sponsors alike have given generously, and because of their efforts, thousands of local residents will receive much needed non-perishable food," stated Jarrett Duncan, CRFP Development Chair. "We are grateful for the community's on-going support."

In addition, the CRFP partners with the United Way of Merrimack County and the local U.S. Postal Carriers' Association each May to donate food collected through the U.S. Postal Carriers' "Stamp Out Hunger" food drive. In 2009, the CRFP's Holiday Food Basket Project provided holiday food baskets to over 2250 families in Merrimack County.
