### **CAPITAL REGION FOOD PROGRAM PURCHASES OVER 1.6 TONS OF FOOD TO AIDE LOCAL FOOD PANTRIES**

CONCORD, NH — The Capital Region Food Program (CRFP) purchased over 200 cases of food for the month of April for its monthly Year Round Distribution Project (YRDP). On April 10<sup>th</sup>, the cases, the equivalent of over 1.6 tons of food, were distributed to 15 local agencies that serve Concord and the surrounding communities. Distribution was held at the Market Basket on Storrs Sreet in Concord.

The recipient agencies were: Boscawen Congregational Church, Boscawen Human Services, Centerpoint Food Pantry, Concord CAP, Concord Human Services, First Congregational, Friends of Forgotten Children, Hopkinton Food Pantry, Immaculate Conception Church, Merrimack Valley Day Care, St. Pauls Food Pantry, and Suncook CAP.

The YRDP donates cases of food to local agencies ten times throughout the year. In 2007, the YRDP distributed over 30 tons of food to its participating organizations, which provided those donations to families in need in the Greater Concord Area.
