

The Capital Region Food Program (CRFP) is a private, not-for-profit, all-volunteer organization whose mission is to help reduce hunger in the Greater Concord Area through distribution of food to individuals and families.

For over 35 years, the CRFP has distributed over 1800 tons of food in the Greater Concord Area by:

- Securing financial contributions from individual donors, local businesses, corporations, and grants.
- Utilizing and coordinating hundreds of volunteers.
- Collaborating with other community distribution and service agencies.

In 2008, the Capital Region Food Program held its 1st Annual Charity Golf Tournament, raising over \$5600, with every dollar going towards the purchase of food. Both the 2nd and 3rd Annual Charity Golf Tournaments raised over \$6000 each. Again every dollar went towards the purchase of food. Additionally, each year the Program has donated the extra meals from the tournament to the Friendly Soup Kitchen in Concord, N.H.
