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CAPITAL REGION FOOD PROGRAM RECIPIENT OF GIVING PROGRAM

CONCORD, NH — The Capital Region Food Program (CRFP) is the recipient of the Concord Cooperative Market's Charitable Giving Program for the month of June.

During the month of June, the Concord Cooperative Market will offer members and shoppers the ability to add a \$1, \$3, or \$5 donation to the CRFP to their order. In addition, when a shopper re-uses a canvas, paper/plastic bag, or cardboard box, the Co-op will donate five cents as a bag refund to the CRFP. Also, during the month of June, information about the CRFP is also featured on the Co-op's bulletin board.

"We are grateful for the Concord Cooperative Market's support of the CRFP and our mission to help reduce hunger in the Greater Concord area", states Maria Manus Painchaud, CRFP Treasurer. "Every dollar donated to our program throughout the year is used to purchase food by the CRFP. As local families continue to struggle with increased food costs, we are pleased we are able to offer assistance to those in need."

In the past 12 months, the CRFP has distributed more than 32 tons of food through it's Year Round Distribution Project. This food is distributed to over 30 local partner agencies who then stock the food in their pantries for families of need in the Greater Concord Area. In addition, the CRFP sponsors the Holiday Food Basket Project, held in partnership with the New Hampshire Army National Guard each December.
