CAPITAL REGION FOOD PROGRAM DISTRIBUTES OVER 1.7 TONS OF FOOD TO LOCAL AGENCIES

CONCORD, NH — The Capital Region Food Program (CRFP) purchased 215 cases of food for the month of February for its monthly Year Round Distribution Project (YRDP). On February 14th, the cases, the equivalent of over 1.7 tons of food, were distributed to 15 local agencies that serve Concord and the surrounding communities. Distribution was held at the Market Basket on Storrs Street in Concord.

The recipient agencies were: Blueberry Express Day Care, Boscawen Congregational Church, Boscawen Human Services, Centerpoint Phileo Pantry, Chichester Town Pantry, Concord Human Services, First Congregational Church, Friends of Forgotten Children, Hopkinton Food Pantry, Immaculate Conception Church, Merrimack Valley Day Care, Pittsfield Food Pantry, St. Peter's Church – Saint Vincent DePaul, St. Paul's Church Food Pantry, and Suncook CAP.

The YRDP donates cases of food to local agencies ten times throughout the year. In 2007, the YRDP distributed over 30 tons of food to its participating organizations, which provided those donations to families of need in the Greater Concord Area.

The Capital Region Food Program, in association with social service agencies, area food pantries, and church groups, has been dedicated to the elimination of hunger in Greater Concord Area since 1974 through distribution of food to individuals and families.
