CAPITAL REGION FOOD PROGRAM SEES 33% INCREASE IN REQUESTED FOOD CASES FOR JULY 2008 DISTRIBUTION

CONCORD, NH — Sixteen local social service agencies, area food pantries, and church groups were the recipients of over 1.9 tons of non-perishable food that was purchased by the Capital Region Food Program (CRFP) for their July Year Round Distribution Project. The 233 cases of food purchased and donated represents a 33% increase in demand over July 2007.

The recipient agencies were: Belknap/Merrimack County CAP, Boscawen Congregational Church, Boscawen Human Services, Centerpoint Food Pantry, Chichester Food Pantry, Concord Human Services, First Congregational Church, Friendly Kitchen, Friends for Forgotten Children, Hopkinton Food Pantry, Immaculate Conception Church Food Pantry, Pittsfield Food Pantry, St. Paul's Church Food Pantry, St Peter's Church St. Vincent de Paul Society, Suncook CAP, and Warner CAP.

In the past 12 months, the CRFP has distributed more than 32 tons of food through it's Year Round Distribution Project, held ten times throughout the year at the Storrs Street Market Basket. This food is distributed to over 30 local partner agencies who then stock the food in their pantries for families of need in the Greater Concord Area. In addition, the CRFP sponsors the Holiday Food Basket Project, held in partnership with the New Hampshire Army National Guard each December.
